Yorkville Homecoming 2024





Mexican Heritage Month

Did you know this month is National Spanish Heritage Month? Each year, Americans observe National Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15, by celebrating the histories, cultures and contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America. The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on September 15 and ending on October 15. It was enacted into law on August 17, 1988, on the approval of Public Law 100-402. The day of September 15 is significant because it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence days on September 16 and September 18, respectively. Also, Columbus Day or Día de la Raza, which is October 12, falls within this 30 day period. YHS Step Team Showcase Camp

Registration is open if you want to sign your student up for the YHS Step Showcase Camp being held on Tuesdays from October 8, 2024 through January 21, 2025 at Yorkville High School Academy located at 702 Game Farm Road, Yorkville, IL 60560. The camp participants will have the opportunity to perform in three showcase performances. Spirit Showcase on Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at Yorkville Middle School, The Yorkville Step Show on Saturday, January 27, 2025 at Yorkville Middle School, and at the Yorkville Black History Celebration on Friday, February 28, 2025 at Yorkville High School.



The camp is open to students in grades 2 and up.

There will be two groups. The first practice is meant for the stepper who has less dance experience or would like a more beginner level routine and will be from 5:45PM-6:45PM. The second practice is meant for the older or more experienced dancer with the ability to focus on a more complicated routine and will be from 6:45PM - 8PM. Group #1 has a tuition of \$90 and group #2 has a tuition of \$120 for the whole 12 week session. A Yorkville step t-shirt is

included in the tuition.

Parent meeting with the Head coach and teaching assistants will be held on Tuesday, September 24th @ 6:30 PM at Yorkville High School Academy - 702 Game Farm Road, Yorkville, IL 60560. This meeting is needed to be sure your students is signed up and all paperwork is completed and tuition is paid (Installments plans available. Select the monthly installment of \$30).

DROP OFF & PICK UP



Please review the reminders below to ensure that all students and parents are safe during pick up and drop off.
