A message from your principal, Dr. Travis

I hope this update finds you well.

Thank you to all of our families who were able to engage in our Curriculum Night earlier this week. It was great to see so many of families in the building -- my compliments to our parents for quickly adapting to the daily bell schedule!

Yorkville High School students have the opportunity to purchase breakfast through the district's expanded meal program. Research has shown that eating breakfast helps improve students' academic performance. Research consistently shows that a healthy breakfast can help students focus in class, score higher on standardized tests, avoid trips to the



nurse, and minimize classroom disturbances. When breakfast is convenient and accessible, more students will participate in this healthy meal and fuel their brains for a day of learning! Breakfast is served on school days, in the main campus and Academy cafeterias from 7:00-7:20 a.m.

In my opening address to students last week, I shared a few modest expectations. We expect that...

- 1. every student experiences academic success (Cs or better in attempted coursework).
- 2. every student discovers an interest or passion.
- 3. every student is connected to at least one school or community based activity.
- 4. every student is connected to at least one trusted peer.
- 5. every student is connected to at least one trusted adult.

While we have an amazing YHS team supporting our students, the true engine of our success is built upon a positive and productive partnership bewteen the home and school. I ask that our families...

- 1. actively engage/review the weekly parent update (every Friday).
- 2. become a Canvas Observer (check Canvas on a weekly basis).
- 3. proactively reach out to your child's teacher/counselor (monthly) don't wait until your student is already in crisis.
- 4. demand high expectations of your child encourage routine practice at home and help them get

- support (before/afterschool, ACCESS, or FlexBlock).
- 5. expect your child to be connected to at least one school or community based activity.
- 6. expect that your student attends **every class** ~ **every day** ~ **on-time** (loss of instructional time rarely is fully recovered)

I know that by working together our students prosper.



National Honor Society (NHS) Applications are now being accepted!

What is the NHS?

The National Honor Society is a nationwide organization for high school students. Selection is based on four criteria: scholarship, leadership, service, and character. Each year students in grades 11 and 12 are invited to apply for membership, based on GPA. During the course of the school year, members are expected to actively participate in NHS sponsored service projects and attend meetings.



Students at Yorkville High School with a cumulative grade point of 3.5 (unweighted) or better, are eligible to pursue membership in the National Honor Society. However, scholarship is only one of the qualifications that must be met, and it alone does not guarantee membership.

Applications are now open!

This completed APPLICATION PACKET MUST be printed, completed, and returned to the main office by the end of the day on Monday, September 23, 2024. There are also paper copies of this application packet available in the Main Office. Students with a GPA less than 3.5 (unweighted) will not be considered. Notification of selection will occur following the faculty panel decision. Induction Night for those selected will occur on Wednesday, November 13, 2024 at 6pm (more details to follow for those invited).

Student Parking Waiting List

YHS has opened up a Parking Waiting List via the Student Payment Portal. Students that have a valid driver's license will be eligible for a space when one becomes available. Once the registration process has been completed, Mrs. Loos will reach out when a spot has been assigned. If a student does not end up receiving a parking spot throughout the year they will be refunded.

In order to park on school property, students must have a parking tag for an assigned parking space. To be eligible for a parking tag, students must complete a parking application and pay the required fees, which can be found in the Student Payment Portal on the Yorkville District #115 Registration Homepage.

All of the following items must be submitted prior to receiving the parking pass:

- Completed application with parent and student signature
- Copy of student driver's license
- Copy of CURRENT insurance.

A copy of the student's driver's license and insurance can be submitted electronically to Dloos@y115.org or in-person during parking permit distribution.

Schedule Changes:

Course Selection and Scheduling

- After three days (8-20 thru 8-28): The student and teacher need to work collaboratively with their
 respective Division Chair to complete the "Course Withdrawal Request Form" that a student will
 pick up from their counselor. The Division Chair will work with the Division Chair for Student
 Support Services to adjust the schedule if needed. Guidance will inform the teacher, student,
 family, and chair of the outcome of the decision.
- After ten days (8-29 and beyond): A withdrawal from class will result in a WF on the transcript. A conference will occur with this process.

Hey Seniors

As a reminder, all seniors must show proof of having had the meningitis vaccine for school attendance this year. Seniors must have at least 1 does of the meningitis vaccine after their 16th birthday. Additionally, as you were notified previously, proof of having the vaccine is required



in order for students to complete the registration process. Hey Freshmen

As a reminder, all students entering 9th grade must have a medical physical exam on the Certificate of Child Health Exam form (Spanish)and updated immunizations on file by October 1, 2024, to avoid being excluded from school. (A sports physical does not meet this requirement). Appointment dates will not be accepted. Additionally, all 9th-grade

students must have proof of a dental exam on file by May 15, 2024. Here is the proof of dental examination form (spanish) that must be submitted.
