General Information:

- All guests 2 years and up must have a ticket; if applicable.
- Guests, Graduates, Faculty & Staff may bring in (1) unopened 20 oz. or smaller bottle of water into the Convocation Center.
 - Please have them refrain from bringing in any other outside beverages (including Starbucks, Dunkin', and other coffee brands).

Clear Bag Policy:

A clear bag policy has been instituted and being enforced at the Convocation Center, the following are permitted:

- Bags that are clear and do not exceed 12" x 12" x 6".
- Small purses which do not exceed 5.5" x 8.5" and no more than 2" thick.
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at the door.

Prohibited Items:

Purses, diaper bags, laptop bags, camera bags, backpacks, duffels, and fanny packs (see Clear Bag Policy) Wrapped gifts and gift bags

Helium Balloons

Laser pointers of any kind

Coolers, bottles, cans, containers, or projectiles

Weapons, flammables, or other potentially dangerous items

Aerosol containers or any pressurized container

Horns, noisemakers, or whistles

Any illegal substances

Posters, banners, or signs on sticks

Golf Umbrellas

Tripods, monopods, & selfie sticks

Outside food & beverages (including Starbucks, Dunkin', and other coffee brands)

Strollers are not permitted in the arena.

Graduates and guests are asked to exit the Convocation Center immediately after the conclusion of the ceremony, if applicable, and ask that they respectfully follow our staff's instructions.

The information below is general ceremony information:

Stage Information:

- Any items/signs you place on the stage, chairs, and seating (including graduates' chairs) are your responsibility to remove after your ceremony.
- We recommend assigning a person on the stage to wipe down microphones after each use or have wipes accessible on the stage.
- If your photographer is taping marks on the floor or stage, please ask her/him to remove them at the end of the ceremony.
- This is your ceremony; feel free to move things around as needed.
