## Parent Tips for School Safety Discussions

- 1. Share the gravity of a mass shooting and that to keep students safe, schools regularly must work with local police and fire departments.
- 2. Teach your kids the slogan: "Run-Hide-Fight" and that it is ok to run away from someone that is trying to hurt them or others.
- 3. Share how important it is to follow the teachers' instructions, but in certain situations, let your child know he/she may have to run away without the teacher.
- 4. Talk to your child about your neighborhood and the area around the school. Identify safe places to run towards, such as a church or fire station.
- 5. Encourage students to be aware of suspicious behavior and to tell a grown-up.
